

# RESOLUTION

## Resolution Supporting the Annual Renewal of maintenance and support for Public Safety Suite Modules with Central Square Technologies (29)

**WHEREAS**, on August 2, 2016, Resolution R-201608-29-188 authorized an Emergency Appropriation to the McHenry County Emergency Telephone System Board's Fiscal Budget for the Purpose of Upgrading TriTech Software Systems Public Safety Computer Aided Dispatch and Inform Mobile Software Modules; and

**WHEREAS**, in September of 2018, TriTech Software Systems merged with three other companies, and now known as CentralSquare Technologies; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tri-Tech software was provided to the three (3) Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP's), twenty-six (26) police departments, and fifteen (15) fire departments within McHenry County; and

**WHEREAS**, the maintenance and support agreement with CentralSquare Technologies enables the McHenry County ETSB to keep current with software updates and provide technical support; and

**WHEREAS**, the ETSB is now requesting that the maintenance and support agreement with CentralSquare Technologies be approved for renewal to cover the period of March 6, 2023 through March 5, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the annual maintenance and support agreement renewal with CentralSquare Technologies is to prevent any interruption to the processing of public safety data; and

**WHEREAS**, the Law and Government/Liquor and Finance and Audit Committees have reviewed the requested action.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by this County Board of McHenry County, Illinois that it hereby supports the McHenry County ETSB in entering into a maintenance and support agreement with CentralSquare Technologies for Public Safety software in an amount not to exceed \$346,181.63 in FY2023; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, said costs for the maintenance and support agreement have been accounted for in the ETSB's fiscal year 2023 budget under budget line item 432100-29-2910-801 (ETSB - Computer Software and Support); and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the County Clerk is hereby authorized to distribute a certified copy of this Resolution to the McHenry County ETSB Director; the County Auditor; the Director of Purchasing; the Chief Financial Officer; and the County Administrator

**Board / Committee Action Requested:**

To support the McHenry County Emergency Telephone System Board's renewal of the maintenance and support agreement with CentralSquare Technologies Public Safety software modules

**Background and Discussion:** In August of 2016, the County Board Authorized an Emergency Appropriation to the McHenry County Emergency Telephone System Board's Fiscal Budget for the Purpose of Upgrading TriTech Software Systems Public Safety Computer Aided Dispatch and Inform Mobile Software Modules. The ETSB is now requesting support for renewal of the maintenance and support agreement on the Public Safety software modules utilized by the three (3) PSAPs, twenty-six (26) police agencies, and fifteen (15) fire agencies.

In September of 2018, TriTech Software Systems merged with three other companies, and is known as CentralSquare Technologies.
