Resolution Authorizing a Two-Year Contract with Two Additional Option Years with Chicago Clinical, dba NICL Laboratories for Laboratory and Diagnostic Testing Services for Valley Hi Nursing Home (61)

WHEREAS, the County utilizes a contract laboratory to provide laboratory and diagnostic related services to the residents at Valley Hi Nursing Home in compliance with applicable State and Federal regulations; and

WHEREAS, the current contract with NICL Laboratories is coming to an end; and

WHEREAS, the Valley Hi Administrator, with the help of the Purchasing Director solicited proposals from multiple laboratory and diagnostic providers, of which NICL Laboratories has been identified as the best, most responsive respondent; and

WHEREAS, NICL Laboratories is a regional company that provides said services to nursing homes and other health care settings that can meet the current and future needs of Valley Hi residents at competitive pricing; and

WHEREAS, NICL Laboratories has been a long time partner of Valley Hi, providing services to the residents and being a participant in the monthly Quality Assurance Committee Meeting which enhances the quality of care provided to the residents; and

WHEREAS, the laboratory and diagnostic testing services have been accounted for in the Valley Hi Operating Budget for FY2023 and will be accounted for in future budgets throughout the term of the contract under the following budget lines: 424860-40-61-6150-800 (X-Ray and Lab Medicare Labs) & 424800-40-61-6150-800 (Medical Services); and

WHEREAS, the Valley Operating Committee and Finance & Audit Committees have reviewed said request.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of McHenry County, Illinois, that it hereby authorizes Valley Hi to enter into a two-year contract with two additional option years starting in FY2023; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said contract costs have been accounted for in the Valley Hi operating budget; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk is hereby authorized to distribute a certified copy of this Resolution to the Valley Hi Administrator, the County Auditor, the Director of Purchasing, the Chief Financial Officer, and the County Administrator.

RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing a Two-Year Contract with Two Additional Option Years with Chicago Clinical, dba NICL Laboratories for Laboratory and Diagnostic Testing Services for Valley Hi Nursing Home (61)

Board / Committee Action Requested:

To approve Valley Hi to seek authorization to enter into a two-year contract with 2 additional option years with NICL Laboratories to provide lab and diagnostic testing to the residents of Valley Hi starting in FY2023.

Background and Discussion:

Valley Hi utilizes a contract laboratory to provide laboratory and diagnostic related services to the residents at Valley Hi Nursing Home in compliance with applicable State and Federal regulations. Services include blood draws, PT/INR Testing, communicable disease testing and other lab based services. The contract laboratory provider is a participant in the facility's monthly Quality Assurance Committee as well.

The current contract with NICL laboratories has expired. The Valley Hi Administrator, along with the McHenry County Purchasing Department solicited proposals from multiple laboratory providers, of which NICL was selected to continue to provide said services to Valley Hi.
