#### **AGREEMENT**

This Agreement entered into this 17th day of EPTEMBER
20/3 A.D, by and between the STATE OF ILLINOIS, acting by and through
its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION hereinafter called the STATE, and the
COUNTY of McHENRY the State of Illinois, hereinafter called the COUNTY.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the STATE in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and ensure safety to the motoring public, is desirous of improving approximately 12.626 feet of US Route 14, FAP Route 305, STATE Section: 27R-3, STATE Job Number: C-91-304-02, State Contract Number: 62517 by reconstructing, widening, milling, and resurfacing:

The project consists of roadway reconstruction, with Portland Cement Concete, to provide 2-lanes in each direction separated by a 22 foot wide raised and landscaped median from Lucas Road to and through the intersection of US Route 14 and Illinois Route 176. From Illinois Route 176 to Crystal Lake Avenue, the improvement consists of widening and resurfacing with hot-mix asphalt. Also included is construction of a multi-use path on the north side of US Route 14, extending from Lucas Road to east of McHenry County Community College. Other work included in the project: earth excavation and embankment, pavement installation, tree removal, unsuitable material and special wasted removals, installation of combination

concrete curb and gutter, open and enclosed drainage systems, traffic signals and interconnection, lighting modification, pavement markings, landscaping, and performing all other work necessary to complete the improvement in accordance with the approved plans and specifications; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is desirous of said improvement in that same will be of immediate benefit to the COUNTY residents and permanent in nature;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- The STATE agrees to make the surveys, obtain all necessary rights of way, prepare plans and specifications, receive bids and award the contract, furnish engineering inspection during construction and cause the improvement to be built in accordance with the approved plans, specifications and contract.
- 2. The STATE agrees to pay for all right of way, construction and engineering cost subject to reimbursement by the COUNTY, as hereinafter stipulated.
- 3. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the estimated cost and cost proration for this improvement is as shown on Exhibit A.
- 4. The COUNTY has passed a resolution appropriating sufficient funds to pay its share of the cost for this improvement, a copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit B" and made a part hereof.

- 5. The COUNTY further agrees that upon award of the contract for this improvement, the COUNTY will pay to the STATE in a lump sum from any funds allotted to the COUNTY, an amount equal to 80% of its obligation incurred under this AGREEMENT, and will pay to said STATE the remainder of the obligation (including any non-participating costs on FA Projects) in a lump sum, upon completion of the project based upon final costs.
- The COUNTY further agrees to pass a supplemental resolution to provide necessary funds for its share of the cost of this improvement if the amount appropriated in "Exhibit B" proves to be insufficient, to cover said cost.
- 7. The COUNTY has adopted a resolution, will send a letter, or sign the Plan Approval page which is part of this document, prior to the STATE advertising for the work to be performed hereunder, approving the plans and specifications as prepared.
- The COUNTY agrees not to permit driveway entrance openings to be made in the curb, as constructed, or the construction of additional entrances, private or commercial, along US Route 14 (FAP Route 305) without the consent of the STATE.
- The COUNTY shall exercise its franchise rights to cause private utilities to be relocated, if required, at no expense to the STATE.

- 10. The COUNTY agrees to cause its utilities installed on right of way after said right of way was acquired by the STATE or installed within the limits of a roadway after the said roadway's jurisdiction was assumed by the STATE, to be relocated and/or adjusted, if required, at no expense to the STATE.
- 11. The COUNTY agrees to obtain from the STATE an approved permit for any COUNTY owned utility relocated/adjusted as part of this improvement, and shall abide by all conditions set forth therein.
- 12. Upon final field inspection of the improvement and so long as US Route 14 is used as a STATE Highway, the STATE agrees to maintain or cause to be maintained the median, the through traffic lanes, left-turn lanes and right turn lanes, and the curb and gutter stabilized shoulders and ditches adjacent to those traffic lanes and turn lanes.
- 13. Upon final field inspection of the improvement, the COUNTY agrees to maintain or cause to be maintained those portions of the improvement which are not maintained by the STATE, including parking lanes and their adjacent curb and gutter, sidewalks, parkways, guardrails, crosswalk and stopline markings, COUNTY owned utilities including appurtenances thereto, highway lighting including furnishing the electrical energy thereof and shall maintain the storm sewers and appurtenances by performing those functions necessary to keep the sewer in a serviceable condition including cleaning sewer lines, inlets, manholes, and catch basins along with the repair or replacement of inlet, manhole and catch basins' frames, grates or lids. The maintenance, repair and/or reconstruction of

storm sewers constructed as part of this improvement beyond the aforedescribed responsibilities shall be that of the STATE.

- 14. The COUNTY further agrees to continue its existing maintenance responsibilities on all side road approaches under its jurisdiction, including all left and right turn lanes under its jurisdiction, including all left and right turn lanes on said side road approaches, up to the through edge of pavement of US Route 14. Drainage facilities, if any, at the aforementioned side roads located within the STATE right-of-way shall be the joint maintenance responsibility of the STATE and the COUNTY unless there is an agreement specifying different responsibilities.
- 15. Upon acceptance by the STATE of the traffic signal work included herein, the financial responsibility for the maintenance and electrical energy charges for the operation of the traffic signal(s) shall be proportioned as follows:

The STATE agrees to make arrangements with the local power company to furnish the electrical energy for the operation of the traffic signals. The STATE agrees to pay their proportionate share of this cost as billed by the local power company.

The STATE retains the right to control the sequence and timing of the traffic signals.

Payment by the STATE of any or all of its share of maintenance and energy costs is contingent upon the STATE receiving adequate funds in its annual appropriation.

The parties hereto agree that the traffic signal maintenance and energy provisions of this Agreement shall remain in effect for a period of twenty (20) years from the date of its execution or so long as the traffic signals covered by the terms of this Agreement or any amendment hereto remain in place either in their current or some modified configuration, whichever, is the shorter period of time. Such an effective term shall apply unless otherwise agreed in writing by the parties hereto.

- 16. The STATE agrees to make arrangements with the local power company to furnish the electrical energy for the operation of the traffic signals. The COUNTY agrees to pay their proportionate share of this cost as billed by the local power company.
- 17. The COUNTY agrees that in the event any work is performed by other than COUNTY forces, the provisions of "an act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in public works by the State, County, or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works" (Illinois Compiled Statutes, 820 ILCS 130/1) shall apply.

Obligations of the STATE and the COUNTY will cease immediately without penalty or further payment being required if, in any fiscal year, the Illinois General Assembly or Federal funding source fails to appropriate or otherwise make available funds for this contract.

This AGREEMENT and the covenants contained herein shall be null and void in the event the contract covering the construction work contemplated herein is not awarded within the three years subsequent to execution of the agreement.

This Agreement shall be binding upon and to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the County agrees to pass a supplemental resolution to provide any necessary funds for its share of the cost of this improvement if the amount appropriated herein proves to be insufficient, to cover said cost; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this project has been designated as Section 13-00424-00-TL; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Board Chairwoman is authorized to execute said agreement; and



<u>Board/Committee Action Requested</u>: Staff requests approval of the resolution approving an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Illinois for improvements to the intersection of U.S. Route 14 and Ridgefield Road.

<u>Background</u>: The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) has prepared plans to reconstruct and add lanes to U.S. Route 14 between Woodstock and Crystal Lake. As part of the project, the intersection of U.S. Route 14 and Ridgefield Road will be realigned and have new traffic signals installed. Per standard IDOT cost participation agreements, the State requires reimbursement from the local agencies having jurisdiction of the local legs. The County is only being required to share in the cost of the traffic signals on Ridgefield Road. The cost for improving the roadway will be paid for by IDOT.

<u>Discussion:</u> This project is currently in IDOT's FY2014 for land acquisition and is being made ready for a January 2014 letting in anticipation of receiving construction funding.

This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the McHenry County State's Attorney Office.
