## RESOLUTION - SUPERMAJORITY

Resolution Authorizing the Emergency Appropriation of \$600,000 in grant funding from the Illinois Department of Public Health to the Department of Health's FY2024 Budget for Respiratory Surveillance Initiatives (51)

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Health has applied for and has been notified of \$600,000 in grant funding for respiratory surveillance initiatives; and

WHEREAS, with the transition out of the pandemic, public health has scaled back COVID-19 surveillance activities and is moving towards integrated surveillance for respiratory illnesses that are epidemic or have pandemic potential, to include, COVID-19, influenza, and respiratory syncytial virus (RSV); and

**WHEREAS**, unlike influenza and RSV, COVID-19 seasonal patterns are not yet possible to predict, but future epidemic waves of SARS-CoV-2 are anticipated, along with the need for ongoing surveillance and preparedness for viral novel variants; and

**WHEREAS**, with the social disruption resulting from COVID-19 removed, seasonal circulation patterns of other respiratory viruses have resumed. The long-term effect of cocirculation and behavioral- and immune-mediated interactions between SARS-CoV-2 and other respiratory pathogens is unknown but is expected to place additional pressure on healthcare systems; and

**WHEREAS,** effective surveillance will help public health officials to rapidly gauge the status of concurrent epidemics and make appropriate decisions to enhance levels of preparedness and response to improve public health outcomes; and

**WHEREAS**, this new grant funding will allow the Department to continue respiratory disease surveillance, provide education and resource support to long term care facilities, and provide rapid testing and education to the general public throughout McHenry County; and

**WHEREAS**, this is a new grant and is not included in the FY2024 budget and requires the approval of the McHenry County Board to appropriate funds; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution has been reviewed by the Board of Health and the Public Health and Community Services and Finance and Audit committees of the County Board and is being recommended to the County Board for approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED,** by this County Board of McHenry County, Illinois, that it hereby authorizes an appropriation in the amount of \$600,000 to the Department of Health's FY2024 budget as follows:
