SUBJECT: Resolution Appropriating Funds for FY2025 Sign Materials (82)

Board / Committee Action Requested:

To approve the resolution accepting bids for sign materials for the FY2025 program and appropriating funds.

Background and Discussion: Bids were opened on September 20, 2024, at the Purchasing Department. The annual bid for sign materials is funded through the County Option Motor Fuel Tax Fund.

This is part of the yearly purchase of various sign materials so the Division of Transportation can maintain signs within County Highway right-of-way.
