Memorandum of Understanding

Between McHenry County Department of Health (MCDH) 2200 N. Seminary Ave., Building A Woodstock, IL 60098

And

Office of Special Projects (Specialty Courts) 22nd Judicial Circuit 2200 N. Seminary Ave Woodstock, IL 60098

The MCDH and Specialty Courts desire to work collaboratively to meet the infection prevention needs of its program participants. This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understanding between the MCDH and Specialty Courts to provide communicable disease testing for its clients.

Background

Specialty Courts applied for and received a grant for its programming. One requirement of the grant is that communicable disease testing will be performed, including testing for HIV, hepatitis and syphilis.

Goal

To meet the grant deliverables and provide access to communicable disease testing, provide community resources for treatment and/or case management, if indicated, as well as education regarding said diseases.

Objectives

- Provide HIV, hepatitis B and C and syphilis testing
- Provide education and community resources for treatment and/or case management as indicated

Participants

Specialty Court Clients, as indicated by Specialty Court staff.

Cost

Specialty Courts will be invoiced monthly or on an as utilized basis based on current MCDH testing fees per Public Health Ordinance, Article VII. Clients will not be billed. Fees are subject to change.

Staff Required

1 Public Health Nurse (RN) for testing and education and/or 1 Administrative Specialist for testing registration and clinic check-in/out

Partnership Deliverables

Specialty Courts will provide:

- Client for said testing
- Specialty Courts staff will call 815-334-4500 to set an appointment for the individual requiring testing. Client name, date of birth, address and email to be provided.

MCDH will provide:

- Testing for HIV, hepatitis B and C and syphilis
- Education will be provided by an RN regarding the transmission, risk behaviors, symptoms, and prevention of said diseases
- Testing result will be shared with client
- Client must fill out a Release of Information (ROI) requesting results be shared with Specialty Courts Staff, as needed

Term and Termination

This MOU is at-will and may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from Specialty Courts and the MCDH in writing. The term of this Agreement shall commence upon execution hereof by both parties and shall perpetuate until either party chooses to terminate. Either party may terminate this agreement with or without cause upon thirty (30) days prior written notice.
