BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk is hereby authorized to distribute a certified copy of this Resolution to the Sheriff, Director of Procurement and Special Services, Auditor, Chief Financial Officer and County Administrator.

Authorization to purchase buildout workstation and fleet storage system solutions for \$67,000 from Shure Manufacturing Corp.

<u>Background and Discussion:</u> The Sheriff determined a need to upgrade workstations and equipment storage area in the garage. This will greatly improve workstation space for fleet mechanics and provide much needed additional storage for tools and equipment.
