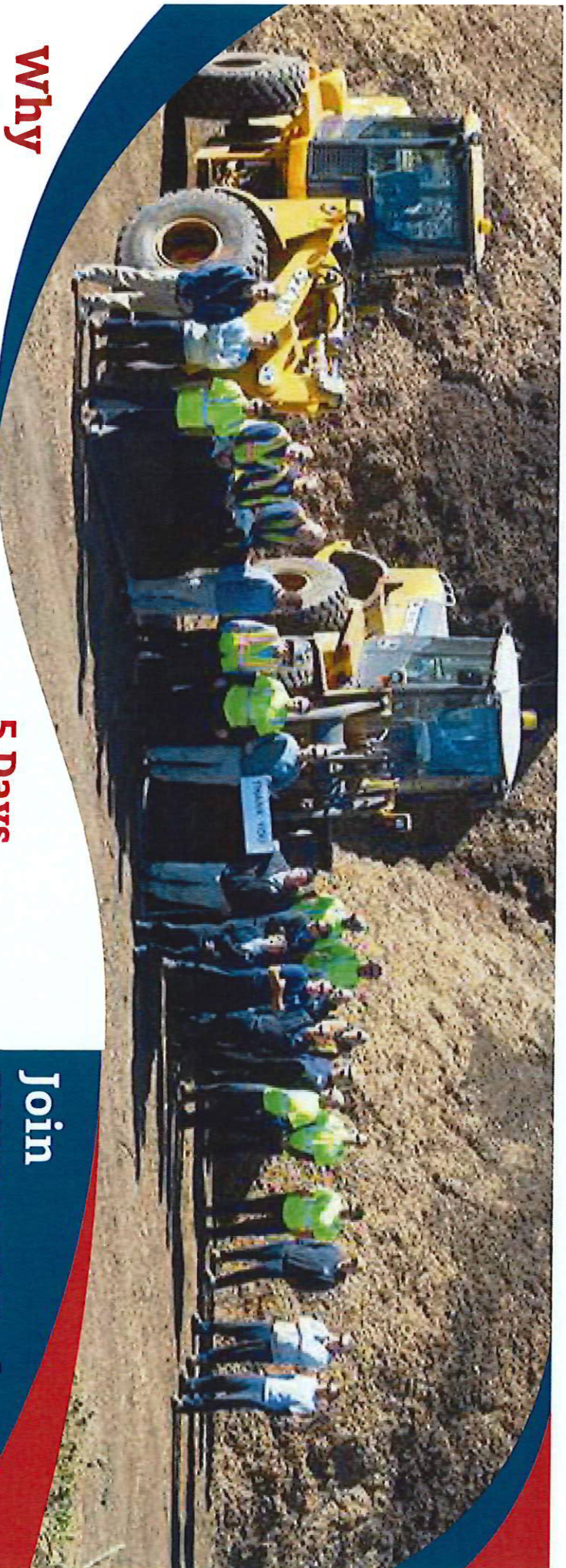

Join IPWMAN?

- Member agencies have access to assets and response teams, from all over Illinois, who assist with everything from debris and material loading and hauling to traffic control, all at no charge.
- IPWMAN coordinates equipment and manpower, and subject matter experts who assist with developing recovery plans, managing personnel, and cost tracking.
- Opportunities for preparedness training and collaboration with other member agencies.
- IPWMAN's standardized operations plan expedites the coordination and arrival of mutual aid, making the disaster response safer and more efficient.
- Being a member of IPWMAN will provide you with peace of mind that your community has access to mutual aid during times of need when local and regional resources are overwhelmed.

5 Days

Member agencies receive 5 free days of assistance per activation.

The annual fee to join IPWMAN is less than the rental cost for one piece of equipment. The operations plan lays out common procedures, to not only increase safety but efficiency.

Dues are based on population served:

<15,000	\$100 per year
15,001 - 75,000	\$250 per year
>75,000	\$500 per year

While there is no obligation to respond, each member agency is encouraged to respond when they are available.
