WHEREAS, the City of Marengo, Illinois intends to use the sum of \$750,000 from McHenry County to satisfy the 20% match requirement under the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) Regional Site Readiness Program; and

WHEREAS, fulfilling this match requirement will enable the City of Marengo to obtain a grant in the amount of \$3,750,000 through the DCEO Regional Site Readiness Program to fund the extension of water and sewer lines to land served by the I-90/Route 23 interchange located within Borrower's municipal boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of McHenry County, Illinois, that it hereby authorizes the County of McHenry to enter into a loan agreement with the City of Marengo in the principal amount of \$750,000 under the terms and conditions agreed upon by both parties attached hereto and made a part hereof, to facilitate the City of Marengo's participation in the Illinois DCEO Regional Site Readiness Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk is hereby authorized to distribute a certified copy of this Resolution to the Mayor of the City of Marengo and the County Administrator.
